The clerk tells him, "No, we don't have a market for it so we don't carry it."




The Barber Shop

"No problem," says the barber. "Just bring it back tomorrow like everyone else does."



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




Resort Trailers (see Page 11) have built a special "Hot Rod Trailer" which will be auctioned off some time during the presentations on Sunday.


The trailer has been custom built to provide that extra space when you go away on those rod runs. You just can't seem to fit everything in the rumble seat!





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


Deep Thoughts by Jack Handy
