CRAKK Memorial Awards

We honour our absent friends with memorial Kroozin' trophies that best epitomise our lost buddies. These awards are in memory of the following rodders who did so much for the CRAKK run while they were with us:

Trevor Abernathy. In 1991, Trevor Abernathy was entrant number 50 at the inaugural CRAKK run. He bought a T Shirt (a size 20) and drove his chopped, yellow 33 Ford tudor. He came back in 1993 in a 35 sedan, and again in 1994 and 1995. In 1996, Trevor won the inaugural Mystery Kroozer award. Sadly, it would be his last CRAKK run, and the Mystery Kroozer award was dedicated to Trevor from this date.

Ross Eldridge. Ross and Nellie Eldridge first came to the CRAKK run in 1998 in their Model A Tourer. They returned the following year, with stories about the progress of their 36 Coupe. In 2000, Ross came to the CRAKK run in a wheelchair, and not long after that he succumbed to motor neuron disease. The Cool Kroozer award was dedicated to Ross.

Bill Lynch. Bill graced the CRAKK run with his presence from the 2000 event. It was not unusual for Bill to stop his Model A Roadster in the middle of the cruising track and tell someone (anyone) that "the keys are in it, off ya go!" Every year, Bill's car would drive past with a different driver, usually with every seat taken up by little kids and big kids. In 2004, Bill suddenly left us before we could say goodbye, and the 2005 CRAKK run included the "Keys are In It" Kroozin' Award in memory of Uncle Bill.

Frank Mardel. The Mardel family came to the CRAKK run in 2001. Not only did they bring a rather large family, but they always had at least three or four hot rods entered. It would be difficult to find a more dedicated rodding family than the Mardels. The family business sponsored the CRAKK run from 2002, and they continued this support every year until Frank's sudden heart attack took him in 2007. Our memorial awards recognise the Most Family Oriented Rodder in memory of Frank Mardel.

Howard Wallace. Howard Wallace supported local rodding in the ACT for many years, and attended the CRAKK run in his red 48 Chev pickup. Howie was famous for his engineering skills and attention to detail, evident in his automotive and motorcycle creations. After a long battle with motor neuron disease, Howard left us with only memories in 2008.

Dennis Moreau. Dennis Moreau was the inaugural President of the CHRA. Dennis co-founded this association with Alan Cooper in 1983, and was prominent in rodding and drag racing right up until his passing on December 19 2011. Today, Dennis' legacy lives on, and the CHRA still welcomes all rodders, regardless of association, despite the technical and political challenges of the day.

Bob Binder. Bob was a local rodder who came to the CRAKK run in the early 90s when he bought Stewy Campbell's 32 roadster. Bob was famous for the different cars he would bring each day of the CRAKK run - a Buick, a Caddy, all with surfboards on the roof and the world's biggest skateboard! A true character, Bob left us in 2017, but his legacy to having fun with cars lives on!

Mick 'Swanny' Swan. We were all so saddened at the passing of everyone's mate, Mick Swan. A true legend, Swanny was loved by all and at every CRAKK run we will miss him dearly. Swanny succumbed to the same disease that took Howard Wallace, Ross Eldridge and one time Meteor Bert Myers.

Mick Cooper. Mick, a 'Batlow Boy,' came to the CRAKK run in his red Model A roadster in the early 2000s and has been a part of the run ever since. His latest car was a Humber Snipe with 350 Chev. Mick left us 2nd December 2020. Mick was always smiling and easy-going, and we shall miss him. His son, Zach, is continuing his latest project.

Tom Matic. After a long battle with MND, Tom left us with memories of his 56 F100 that attended so many CRAKK runs. A member of the Wizards and the CHRA, Tom was a long time Hot Rodder that everyone knew.

Rest in peace, friends. We will never forget you.

Helpful hints for the Meticulous Hot Rodder, from the chronicles of A. Nong, Dumb Shifts CC

Many Hot Rod owners fail to take advantage of up-to-date restoration techniques and materials. One product that is very useful is the modern spray paint can. These are available almost everywhere in a variety of colours.

Here are a few helpful hints incorporating the use of this handy tool:

Engine Compartment - The great thing about spray cans is your ability to hold them right up to the surface to be painted. This eliminates the bother of removing the spark plugs, wires and other objects when painting your car's engine. Simply hold the can's nozzle within a few mm of the engine, and you can paint all around the plugs and other accessories. Don't worry about runs as they will work their way down the block and drip harmlessly to the floor. Using the same technique, you can paint the air cleaner, starter, supercharger housing, water pump and alternator in a contrasting colour which, even if not original, authentic or even very cool, will draw attention to your efforts. It would, however, be a good idea to have an old rag handy to wipe off the excess that dribbles down over the freshly-painted engine block.

Wire Wheels - There's no need to spend huge amounts of money on chrome plating wire wheels when you can use a can of silver paint that will give about the same effect. A real plus is that you needn't remove the tyres. Just jack up each wheel, give it a good spin and shoot the paint at the rim, spokes, and hub as they revolve rapidly. You can always go back and brush black paint over the silver that gets onto the tyres. Don't worry about over spray on brake drums and chassis; grease and road dirt will soon cover that nicely.

Instrument Panel - Some rodders go to a lot of trouble removing their instrument panels prior to painting. This is not necessary. You also do not need to spend a lot of money having some expert put a fancy wood-grain finish on the dash. Using this simplified process and two cans of spray paint, you can still achieve remarkable results on your own:

Step One -Spray the entire panel with light brown paint until it is completely covered.

Step Two -Select a dark brown paint and spray very heavily along the top edge only. You'll really need to flood it on so that it runs down evenly over the lighter colour. You'll be amazed at how the natural flow of the paint simulates real wood. In fact, it closely resembles rotary-cut plywood.

Step Three- Moisten a rag with solvent and wipe the paint off the instruments and knobs before it dries.


Using this method, the results were shown to a fellow Hot Rodder. He was so impressed with the result that he said, "Oh my God!" and promptly left, no doubt in his haste to rush home and try it on his own car.

Exterior Body - Many cars can be painted using only a few spray cans. It's not necessary to invest a great deal of time or money on a professional paint job to achieve fabulous results. Hold the spray can in your right hand and a whisk broom in the other as you work your way in a clockwise direction around your Hot Rod. You really do get a better job if you knock off the dust and most of the encrusted dirt before spraying. No need to bother with fancy spray booths either. Merely pull your car out of the garage into the back yard and, with a light breeze blowing to prevent dust from settling onto the surface, you can easily finish the job in under an hour.

These are just a few of the time and moneysaving ideas for using spray cans. No doubt our many perfection-minded Hot Rod owners can come up with still more and varied uses.




For a number of years now, work has been proceeding in order to bring perfection to the crudely conceived idea of a transmission that would not only supply inverse reactive current for use in unilateral phase detractors, but would also be capable of automatically synchronizing cardinal grammeters. Such an instrument is the turbo encabulator.

Now basically the only new principle involved is that instead of power being generated by the relative motion of conductors and fluxes, it is produced by the modial interaction of magneto-reluctance and capacitive diractance.

The original machine had a base plate of prefamulated amulite surmounted by a malleable logarithmic casing in such a way that the two spurving bearings were in a direct line with the panametric fan. The latter consisted simply of six hydrocoptic marzlevanes, so fitted to the ambifacient lunar waneshaft that side fumbling was effectively prevented.

The main winding was of the normal lotus-odelta type placed in panendermic semi-boloid slots of the stator, every seventh conductor being connected by a non-reversible tremie pipe to the differential girdle spring on the "up" end of the grammeters.

The turbo-encabulator has now reached a high level of development, and it's being successfully used in the operation of novertrunnions. Moreover, whenever a forescent skor motion is required, it may also be employed in conjunction with a drawn reciprocation dingle arm, to reduce sinusoidal repleneration.







Relay configurations and types


In addition to the basic make & break relays, ISO relays are available in a number of other common configurations which are described in the table below:


Description

Make & break relay




The simplest form of relay. The circuit between terminals 30 and 87 is made when the relay is energised and broken when de-energised. These relays are either NO (Normally Open) or NC (Normally Closed). The one shown here is NO.

Changeover relay




Two circuits (terminals 87 and 87a) have a common terminal (30). When the relay is at rest 87a is connected to 30, and when the relay is energised 87 becomes connected to 30 (but never both at the same time).

Relay with double output



Terminal 87 is linked to pin number 87b, giving double outputs from the single NO contact.

Relay with dual contacts



The armature contacts both terminal 87 and (in this case) 87b at the same time when the coil is energised, creating a dual NO output




Circuit schematic Description

Relay with integrated fuse



A blade or ceramic fuse is connected between terminal 30 and the NO contact, providing built-in protection for the high current circuit. The fuse is normally mounted in a holder moulded as part of the relay body so it can be replaced if it blows.


Relay with diode across the coil



When de-energised, the magnetic field around the coil collapses rapidly, inducing a voltage spike in the opposite direction to the energising voltage (+12V). The collapse is so rapid the voltages can be in the order of several hundred volts (although very low current).

This spike can damage sensitive electronic devices such as control modules in alarm systems and engine management systems. A diode across the coil can prevent this damage by absorbing the high voltage spikes and dissipating them within the coil/diode circuit. The diode will always be installed in the relay with the stripe on the diode body facing towards terminal 86 (reverse biased) and it is important that +12V is connected this terminal (with 85 connected to ground) or the diode could be damaged.

Relay with resistor across the coil



A high value resistor performs a similar function to that of the diode in the previous configuration by absorbing the high voltage spikes created by the collapsed magnetic field on de-energisation of the coil. The disadvantage of a resistor is that it allows a small current to flow in normal operation of the relay (unlike a diode) and is not quite as effective as a diode in suppressing voltage spikes, but it is less susceptible to accidental damage because resistors are not sensitive to polarity.






